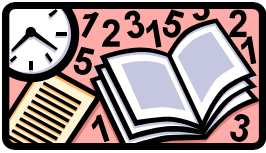

DRESS CODE

Students and school personnel are to dress in a reasonable and modest manner. The dress should be

business-like and not be a distracting factor to the learning environment. Students are responsible for observing basic standards of cleanliness and grooming and are expected to dress appropriately for school. The principals will make the final decision and could require a student to change clothing or return home to change into more appropriate attire. Clothing considered inappropriate for school includes: shirts with bare midriffs, tank tops or muscle shirts, halter tops, tube tops or similar styled clothing, the display of undergarments and underwear, cut-off shorts, spaghetti straps, strapless shirts, and clothing accessories with suggestive, offensive or profane slogans or advertisements including references to cigarettes, illegal narcotics, and alcoholic beverages. Shirts must be worn at all times even on the sports field. Shoes or sandals must be worn at all times. While students may wear hats to school, they should not be worn in school buildings and classrooms.
