

Dear Parents/Guardian of returning students,

According to the health services policy of the American Cooperative School of Tunis, it is a requirement that all parents provide the school nurse with a new student medical examination for all returning students entering grades 3, 6, and 9, and annually for any student wishing to participate in athletics at the high school.

The goal of the student medical examination is to ensure that the school has the most current medical information pertaining to your child's health and immunization status. This will assist us in providing the most appropriate and safe environment for your child. Updating your child's medical records will inform the nurse and faculty of any current or ongoing special needs and developments involving your child.

Please take this opportunity to obtain a comprehensive physical examination, as it is an important developmental stage in your child's life. Early intervention is critical to providing optimal physical wellbeing. Immunization records should also be reviewed with your physician and updated as needed.

This form may be completed in your home country but must be for the current school year and completed no early than 6 months prior to the start of the school term.

The medical exam must be completed on the ACST student medical examination form. A link to this form can be found on this website for your convenience.

This form must be signed by a physician and a parent or guardian, and returned to the school nurse office. Do not submit the form to the student's teacher or to the division office.

Thank you for your cooperation. Please return the completed form by the first week of the new school year so that any special needs can be identified and the appropriate medical response initiated.
